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REPLY AFFIDAVIT TO THE AFFIDAVIT DATED 21.02.2022

I, Gp Capt VK Gandhi, S/o Sh IS Gandhi, aged about 72 years, R/o 801, Narmada 5, D-6 Vasant Kunj, New Delhi 110070, General Secretary of the Indian Ex-Servicemen Movement, do hereby solemnly and sincerely affirm that I am authorised representative of the Petitioners herein and am well acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case and hence am competent to submit this reply affidavit to the affidavit filed by the Union of India dated 21.02.2022.

PRELIMINARY SUBMISSIONS

1. The chart (**Pg. 3, CC**) with the Extract of F.No.1(1)/2019/D(Pen/Pol) (**Pg. 2-5, AD** given on 1.02.2022), clearly indicate that the MACP scheme came into effect from 1.1.06. Therefore, the figure of Rs. 6665 referring to the pension of a sepoy (**Pg. 3, CC**) should invariably factor the benefits of the MACP scheme. This is also apparent from note 6 which refers to MACP at the bottom of the chart.

2. Arguendo, if the figure of Rs. 6665 did not factor MACP, the following would be the sequitur:

a) The MACP was not given to those personnel despite them being eligible for the same;

b) Two retirees despite the same length of service one prior to 2013 and the other post 2013 will not get the benefit of MACP; and

If the principle in sub-para b, supra, is accepted, it would throw the concept of OROP to the winds as two persons with the same rank and the same length of service would be getting different pensions.

3. The statement, that persons prior to 2014 are not exigible to MACP is thus patently false.

4. The Petitioner's case is that the Koshyaari Committee Report dated 19.12.2011 (**Pg. 73 at 79-80**) read with the Finance Ministers speech dated 17.2.2014 (**Pg. 101-102**) culminated in an executive decision in the form of the minutes dated 26.2.2014 chaired by the Raksha Mantri (**Pg. 103**). These minutes were thereafter enclosed along with the letter dated 26.02.2014 (**Pg. 105**), a copy of which was also furnished to the highest executive officers by the communication of even date (**Pg. 106**). This is further buttressed by statement dated 7.7.2014 (**Pg. 107**) of the Ministry of Finance read with statement dated 2.12.2014 of the MOS Defence (**Pg. 109**). It would therefore be purile to contend that the aforesaid minutes did not constitute an executive decision taken by the UOI. This position is further illustrated by the fact that if this was not a policy decision then the question of its implementation, which is the object of the aforementioned correspondence does not arise. Therefore, it is submitted the impugned communication dated 07.11.2015 (**Pg. 110**) is dehors the earlier executive decision taken at a much higher level and is

thus palpably arbitrary being inconsistent with the same. To read the communication dated 07.11.2015 in isolation is erroneous.

5. Without prejudice to the above it is submitted that the conditions stipulated in paragraphs 3 (i) to 3(v) of the communication dated 7.11.2015 (**Pg. 111**), are not stipulated in the notification dated 14.12.2015 (**Pg. 113**). It is submitted that the said notification substitutes the concept of automatic enhancement of pension with bridging the gap with "periodic intervals". Even assuming that the policy decision dated 07.11.2015 is only encompassed in the notification dated 14.12.2015, the same is arbitrary because by introducing the concept of periodic intervals, the period cannot be so large so as to make the concept of one rank one pension illusory and in effect decree one rank different pensions. This, would be the practical effect of equalizing the pension after a period of 5 years. In sum, the equalization after a period of 5 years is arbitrary and does not have statutory sanction as the same is not part of the notification 14.12.2015.
6. The fixation of the calendar year 2013 and the effective date being fixed as 1.7.2014 is yet again arbitrary and will result in one rank different pensions and is not sanctioned by the notification dated 14.12.2015.
7. The submissions of the ASG is contrary to the statement by two ministers of finance, the minute of a committee chaired by the Defence minister and yet another statement by the Minister of State of Defence.

REPLY TO THE AFFIDAVIT DATED 21.02.2022


A. Relevance of the statement made by the Hon'ble Finance Minister

8. It is a well-known fact that the budget speech is made in the Parliament after receiving prior approval from the Prime Minister and his Cabinet. Rejecting the statement made by the Finance Minister in his budget speech reflects poorly on morality of the government.

B. Figures provided by the Respondent are incorrect

9. The underlying assumption of the calculations at Page No. 15 of the affidavit dated 21.02.2022 is incorrect. The calculations are premised on an incorrect understanding of the Petitioner's submissions, to wit, that the Petitioners are claiming One Rank One Pension (OROP) for all retired personnel irrespective of their length of service. After conflating the said argument of the Petitioners with the number of personnel to whom pensions would have to be given irrespective of their length of service after factoring MACP, the Respondents have come up with a figure of Rs. 9411.71 crores. This assumption is wholly fallacious as the Petitioner has never argued that a retiree who has lesser years of service should get pension similar to a personnel who has put in more years of service. In fact, it has been the consistent case of the Petitioner that OROP implies to all persons with the same rank, irrespective of their date of retirement should get the same pension if they had put in the same number of years of service. The financial implications to the Respondent, if MACP is factored based on this principle should be as follows :

a.	Difference of financial implication per annum	Rs. 338.4 crores (Rs. 11280 X 3,00,000)

c.	Conversion in 7 th CPC	Rs. 869.7 crores (Rs. 338.4c X 2.57 times)
d.	Further arrears from 01.01.2016	Rs. 5218.2 crores (Rs. 869.7c X 6 years)
e.	DR arrears from 01.01.2016 to 31.12.2021	Rs, 600 crores (Rs. 869.7c/12 X 8.28)
Total additional arrear		6325.8 (b+d+e)

Note:

- i. Difference in payment is Rs. 940 per person per month (**Pg. 1 of the note and Pg. 10 of the Comprehensive Affidavit**) i.e., Rs. 940 X 12 = Rs. 11,280 per year
- ii. No. of years = 1978 to 2014 i.e., 36 years
- iii. Every year about 50,000 armed personnel retire from service (**Chart at Pg. 4 of the Affidavit dated 21.02.2022**). 50,000 X 36 = 18,00,000 i.e., 18,00,000 soldiers have retired
- iv. No. of soldiers given arrear = 21,00,000 (**Pg. 6 of Reply to Comprehensive Affidavit**)
- v. No. of soldiers left = 3,00,000 (iv - iii)

The Respondents have confirmed that MACP is applicable from 1998 onwards and also that all personnel retiring on that date in 1998 has been given advantage of MACP. This means that all personnel joining armed forces prior to 1998 has only been denied MACP. This number comes to mere 3,00,000.

10. Similarly, the figure of Rs. 14898.34 crores mentioned at Page No. 16 of the affidavit dated 21.02.2022 is exaggerated and fallacious. This is so for the following reasons:

- i. If OROP is granted to all 21 lakh ex-servicemen, the total expenditure per year will be Rs. 2910.81 Crores (Rs. 10034.19 crores - 7123.38 crores). True copy of the chart financial

implication on implementation of one rank one pension is annexed as **Annexure A-1.** (Pg. 9)

Note:

The actual amount allegedly spent by the Respondent as per their submission is Rs. 7123.38 Crores while the amount which is granted by the Respondent is Rs. 5387.67 Crores (Option 2). The difference/ additional amount allegedly spent is Rs. 1,735.71 Crores. The amount which should be granted is Rs. 8298.48 Crores. Adding the difference of Rs. 1,735.71 Crores to Rs. 8298.48 Crores, comes to a total of Rs. 10034.19 Crores. Interestingly, the additional burden on account of MACP is also subsumed in the above figure.

- ii. The figures stated in the Affidavit dated 21.02.2022 settled by the Ld. ASG is grossly inflated figures that has been taken by making incorrect assumptions.
- iii. The following is the difference between the financial implication on grant of OROP as claimed by the Respondent and what has been actually granted:

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It is relevant to note that X group receives the highest pension, Y group receives around Rs. 600/- less than X category.

C. Factual Disparity

11. In order to prove the contention that the scheme called OROP is flawed and violated the integrity of the principle that servicemen retiring in the same rank with the same length of service are not getting the same pension, the Petitioner seeks to place on record live cases in all the three categories namely, Sepoy, Naik and Havildar. It is evident that armed personnel retiring after 2014 are getting more pension than pre 2014 retirees. It is against the principle of OROP to draw an arbitrary line as held in *SPS Vains*. The Petitioners categorically state OROP is given to one and all irrespective of the date of retirement. True copy of the documents placing on record live cases in all the three categories namely, Sepoy, Naik and Havildar is annexed as **Annexure A-2. (Pg. 10 to 21)**

12. The relevant extract from the letter dated 17.01.2013 of the Ministry of Defence is produced below:

"2.1. The pension of pre-01.01.2006 JCO/OR pensioners may be determined on the basis of notional maximum for the ranks and group across three Services.."

This is contrary to the stand taken in the affidavit that a mean of the maximum and minimum pension has to be taken.

True copy of the letter dated 17.01.2013 is annexed as **Annexure A-3.** (Pg. 22 to 23)

D. 'Automatic' cannot be replaced with 'periodic'

13. One Rank One Pension (OROP) for ex-servicemen with effect from 01.07.2014 implies that uniform pension be paid to the Defence Forces Personnel retiring in the same rank with the same length of service, regardless of their date of retirement, which implies bridging the gap between the rates of pension of the current pensioners and the past pensioners at periodical intervals. The point to be noted here is that last line has been deleted and word automatically has been replaced with periodical intervals which in turn is further truncated by having a gap of 5 years. This has killed the soul of OROP and created class within a class which is not permitted as per Article 14 of Constitution and has been challenged in the petition.

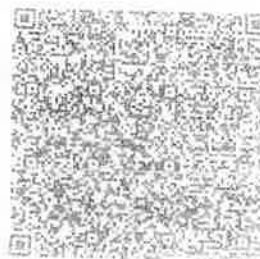

Subject: - Implementation of Government decision on the recommendations of the Committee of Secretaries 2012 on the issues related to Defence Service Personnel and Ex-Servicemen- Improvement in pension of JCO/OR retired/discharged/invalided out of service prior to 1.1.2006.

Sir,

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No. PC 10(1)/2009-D (Pen/Policy) dated 8.3.2010 according to which with effect from 1st July 2009, pension of all ranks of pre-1.1.2006 JCO/OR retiree in Army, Navy and Air Force (including DSC and TA) has been reckoned at 50% of notional pay in the post-1.1.2006 revised pay structure corresponding to the maximum of the pay scales applicable from 10.10.1997 of the rank and group continuously held for last 10 months preceding retirement/discharge/invalidment. The amount of pension so determined has to be reduced pro-rata if the reckonable qualifying service including rank weightage (except TA personnel) is less than service required to earn full pension.

2. A Committee of Secretaries headed by Cabinet Secretary was constituted by the Government to consider various issues on pension of Armed Forces personnel and Ex-Servicemen, who have recommended the following to bridge the gap in pension between pre and post-1.1.2006 JCO/OR pensioners-

2.1 The pension of pre-1.1.2006 JCO/OR pensioners may be determined on the basis of notional maximum for the ranks and group across the three Services; and

2.2 Current weightage in qualifying service of Sepoy, Naik and Havildar may be increased by two years.

3. The above recommendations of the Committee has been accepted by the Government and the President is pleased to decide that with effect from 24th September 2012, the service pension, invalid pension, special pension, service element of disability pension and service element of war injury/liberalized disability pension (in release cases only) of all pre-1.1.2006 JCO/OR pensioners of Army, Navy and Air Force (including DSC & TA) shall be recomputed in terms of Para 2 of this Ministry's above said letter dated 8.3.2010 after determining the highest of notional pay in the revised pay structure corresponding to maximum of pay scales of Fifth CPC across the three Services equivalent to the rank and group in which pensioned. Before determining highest of notional pay of equivalent ranks across three Services, 50% of highest classification allowance (rates effective from 1.9.2008) shall also be added in the notional pay of the ranks in Army, wherever applicable.



5.2 Constant Attendance Allowance, where admissible.

6. The provisions of this order shall be effective from 24th September 2012. No arrears on account of revision of pension based on notional fixation of pay shall be admissible for the past period. However, If a pensioner to whom the benefits under these orders accrues has died / dies before receiving the payment on account of arrears, the life time arrears (LTA) will be disposed off as per the extant orders contained in Para 12 of this Ministry above said letter dated 8.3.2010

METHODOLOGY FOR IMPLEMENTATION

7. All Pension Disbursing Agencies handling disbursement of pension to Defence pensioners are hereby authorized to carry out revision of service pension/special pension/ invalid pension/service element of disability pension with effect from 24th September 2012 to the affected pensioners drawing pension with 15 years or more qualifying service in terms of these orders without calling for any applications from the pensioners and without any further authorization from the concerned Pension Sanctioning Authorities and pay the arrears on account of such revision.

8. In order to quicken the processes of revision of service pension, special pension, invalid pension, service element of disability pension with 15 years or more qualifying service, total 25 tables indicating revised pension payable with effect from 24th September 2012, have been prepared for PBOR of Regular Army, Navy, Air Force and DSC who retired/discharged/invalided out from service prior to 1.1.2006 and drawing pension as on 24th September 2012, and are enclosed as **Appendix** to this letter. The appended tables indicate the existing pension as on 1.7.2009 and revised pension payable with effect from 24th September 2012. Pension Disbursing Agencies shall revise the pension with reference to applicable Table for the rank and group in which the JCO/OR was pensioned. The revised rate of pension indicated against each qualifying service in the pension tables appended to this letter is inclusive of rank weightage applicable for various ranks, Pension Disbursing Authority shall refer the actual qualifying service as shown in Column-1 for carrying out revision subject to maximum term of engagement for each rank as applicable from time to time. In addition, dearness relief sanctioned by the Government from time to time and applicable quantum of additional pension for pensioners of 80 years of age and above, is also payable.

9. The initial Pension Payment Order (PPO) or its Corrigendum PPO (Corr PPO) indicates rank, group and qualifying service for which the individual has been pensioned. This information is available with Pension Disbursing Agencies as they have revised pension of all such pensioners in the recent past in terms of various Government orders. In case, however, any information regarding qualifying service, rank, group etc., is not available with Pension Disbursing Agencies, such cases may be referred to Pension Sanctioning Authority concerned on the proforma enclosed as **Annexure-A**. The Pension Sanctioning Authorities concerned will provide the requisite information from the available records within 30 days of the receipt of request from the Pension Disbursing Agencies.

CASES REQUIRING REVISION FROM PSAs

10. Pension of PBOR pensioners who are in receipt of Special Pension, Invalid Pension and service element of Disability Pension for less than 15 years of qualifying service would also need to be revised in terms of these orders. Specific Tables for the purpose have not been prepared for the reason that each of such cases will be unique one as rank, group and qualifying service will differ from case to case and hence standard Tables cannot be prepared. Pension Disbursing Agencies shall refer such cases directly to the Pension Sanctioning Authorities concerned in the format enclosed as **Annexure-B** to this letter.

11. Specific tables for revision of pension in respect of pre-1.1.2006 Territorial Army pensioners have also not been prepared as Pension Disbursing Agencies could not revise such cases due to non-applicability of weightage in qualifying service and provision for reduction in
